The Events of 2012

Bus Trip to Greektown, Detroit, Mi – Our 4rd Annual Casino Bus Trip took us to Greektown on April 29 at 7:30 am. We had a total of 46 people participate this year! Once again, Sally Roth kept us well informed and taken care of during our trip by providing beverages, snacks, and a bagged lunch. The winner of this year's horse race was "HOMER"! We had a 50/50 raffle, and a reverse raffle. There were a few big winners on this trip. Congratulations to you all! Our total donation was \$2,292.00.

Pink Day at Schuster's Greenhouse - On May 19th, Schuster's Greenhouse in Elyria had a "Pink Day" to raise money for breast cancer research. They set up a tent specifically for Power 4 Pink. They had free punch, cookies and cupcakes, and breast cancer merchandise for sale. They also had a Chinese raffle and set up a donation jar. Even certain plants were "on sale" with a portion of the proceeds being donated to the cause. In all, we received a donation of \$605.90.

Wellington Gun Raffle/Show - On May 19th, the Wellington Eagles invited us to the Wellington Gun Show, where we put up an information table. Since we are a local organization, they donated \$.50 per ticket sold. But they didn't stop there! There were many raffles and door prizes, and many people stopped by our table just to give a donation to the cause. And the flow of people stopping was constant because the MC kept announcing our name and telling people to stop and see us! Through the efforts of the Wellington Eagles, the Power 4 Pink organization will received at least \$2,500.00. They were extremely proud to support a local organization such as ours.

Poker Run with the Wellington Eagle Riders - On June 2nd, 42 vehicles and 80 motorcycles participated in the Breast Cancer Run. The run started at the Wellington Eagles #2051 on South Main Street in Wellington with the first bike out at 12:00pm. The Poker Run covered 5 stops and 145 miles through Lorain County. The first stop was at the Mercy Cancer Center in Lorain, then on to the Vermilion VFW, Bellevue F.O.E. #490, FatHeads in Republic, New London F.O.E. #2869, and then back to Wellington #2051. Lots of participants were wearing pink shirts, pink hats, pink scarves, and even pink hair! The last of the riders arrived back at the Wellington Eagles at 6:30pm. The Wellington Eagles provided food for everyone at the end of the run. They estimated that over \$7,500.00 was raised, and a portion of the proceeds will donated to Power 4 Pink Incorporated.
